General Information

A civil marriage ceremony can take place in any register office in England or Wales, or at any venue that has been approved to hold a civil marriage.

You both need to go to your local register office to give notice of your intention to marry. If you plan to marry in a different area, you should also contact the register office for the district in which the marriage is due to take place.

What is a notice of marriage?

It is a legal requirement to give notice of marriage and, once given, your notice of marriage is displayed on the notice board at the register office for a period of fifteen clear days. Your notice of marriage is valid for 12 months.

A notice of marriage is a legal document required by the Marriage Act 1949 and states for each person:

name and surname

age

condition

address

occupation

nationality

intended marriage venue
