# The beginnings

Once you have announced your engagement it's time to think about the first questions.

When would you like to get married? What is your budget? Do you want a lavish, large wedding or a more simple, intimate wedding? Will it be a civil or church wedding/service?

#### Guests:

Start thinking about the number of guests you would like and who to have as your best man, maid of honour, ushers, and flower girls, then start delegating! Your maid of honour and best man particularly can be of great help.

#### Bookings:

Have a look around the several different venues on offer at Milsom Weddings, it's best to book 12 months ahead but always give us a call as we may have availability. Remember certain venues are ideal for different sized ceremonies and receptions.

Milsom Weddings can also advise on local churches.

As soon as you decide on a date, confirm your ceremony and venue you can send preliminary 'save the date' cards.

#### Accommodation:

It may be wise to provisionally reserve some accommodation for your guests if they are travelling to the area for the wedding. Speak to one of our co-ordinators if you think this might be necessary.

#### Wedding formalities:

It's a great idea to take out wedding insurance.

#### The dress:

Start looking for the dress; let your bridal shop or seamstress know your budget. Also look for the bridesmaids, groom and the other outfits, find out if they have any particular needs or wants.

#### Suppliers:

Start to look for some suppliers you may want to use, have a look on here to see who we recommend. Book your music, flowers, photographer etc. as soon as possible to ensure availability.
